Working Together To Feed Our Neighbors

Community Food Share is the Feeding America food bank fighting hunger in Boulder and Broomfield Counties. By providing access to fresh, nutritious food through local partners and on-site and mobile pantries we are committed to nourishing our neighbors facing food insecurity.

Hunger remains a significant challenge in Boulder and Broomfield Counties, impacting thousands of individuals and families. 1 in 10 people in the region—41,320 individuals, representing 10.3% of the total population—struggle with food insecurity, lacking consistent access to enough nutritious food to lead active, healthy lives. This burden is particularly heavy on children, with 7,010 children (9.3%) in the two-county area facing food insecurity, or 1 in 12 children.

Additionally, we collaborate with over 40 hunger-relief partners to ensure efficient food distribution across our region. Community Food Share is proud to have served 60,000 people and distributed 13 million pounds of food last year alone!

A portion of the proceeds will be donated to Community Food Share serving Boulder and Broomfield Counties.
